### Sparkling and Champagne

- Prosecco Spumante Extra Dry, NV, Veneto, Italy** £25.00  
*Pale yellow gold in colour offering a bouquet of pear drops, lemon and melon. Light and fresh on the palate with a clean finish.*
- Gardet Brut Tradition, Champagne NV, France** £42.00  
*Floral and citrus notes with a rich palate and delicate mousse*
- Champagne Gardet Rose Brut, Champagne, NV, France** £45.00  
*A delicious rosé with summer berry and citrus flavours with a crisp and refreshing finish. Elegance combined with a rich and fruity core, sturdy enough to serve with food.*
- Champagne Gosset Excellence, Brut, NV, France** £60.00  
*Intense nose of fresh floral honeysuckle and white jasmine followed by exotic pineapple and mango flavours.*

### Rooms on Regent's Park Preferred Wine

- Crucillon Viura Blanco, Campo de Borja, Spain** £20.00  
*A lovely balanced white with stone fruits, citrus and floral lift.*
- Ochoa Calendas Viura Chardonnay, Navarra, Spain** £22.00  
*Viura grape has high acidity that creates refreshing wines whilst Chardonnay brings the structure. Overall it is fruity and fresh with floral notes.*

### Rooms on Regent's Park Preferred Wine

- Vina Temprana 'Old Vines' Garnacha, Campo de Borja, Spain** £20.00  
*Ripe red berry fruits with lifted spice and soft tannins.*
- Ochoa Calendas Tempranillo Garnacha, Navarra, Spain** £22.00  
*Lovely red wine with intense and ripe red berry aromas from the garnacha grape and good structure with round tannin from tempranillo*



## White Wine

- Freedom Cross, Chenin Blanc, Franschhoek, South Africa** £22.<sup>00</sup>  
*Ripe apple with tropical flavours leading to a clean, dry finish*
- Altana di Vico, Pinot Grigio, Veneto, Italy** £22.<sup>00</sup>  
*Clean and crisp with aromas of citrus fruits, the palate is fresh with citrus fruits and pear.*
- Domaine Pellehaut Blanc, Cotes de Gascogne, France** £23.<sup>00</sup>  
*Aromas of citrus fruits and acacia flower with touch of exotic fruits.  
A remarkable balance between the freshness and the aromatic presence.*
- Zapallar Sauvignon Blanc Reserva, San Antonio, Chile** £23.<sup>00</sup>  
*This Sauvignon Blanc balances the grassy, cool climate style with delicate floral elderflower aromas and a little exotic fruit character.*
- Mount Brown Sauvignon Blanc, Waipara, New Zealand** £25.<sup>00</sup>  
*Intense passion fruit and ripe tropical fruits on the nose. Pineapple and exotic fruit  
Flavours backed up by a lemon-lime minerality lead this fine well-balanced wine  
to a palate of great depth and flavour with a dry citrus finish*
- Petit Chablis Domaine d'Elise 2015, Burgundy, France** £28.<sup>00</sup>  
*Chablis at its best with crisp green apple up front giving way to  
flinty mineral notes and creamy mouth feel.*
- Arcan Albarino, Galicia, Spain** £30.<sup>00</sup>  
*Galicia's signature grape variety displaying intense notes of white fruit, pears,  
citrus fruits and mouth-watering acidity*
- Sancerre Domaine Millet Roger, Loire Valley, France** £32.<sup>00</sup>  
*Concentrated gooseberry and citrus fruit, this wine is full of complexity  
with the classic minerality so traditional of Sancerre.*

## Rosé Wine

- Domaine Pellehaut Rose, Cotes de Gascogne, France** £20.<sup>00</sup>  
*A beautifully fresh and fruity rosé made with Tannat, Merlot and Syrah.  
Cherry notes, citrus fruits and white flowers shine through the palate.*

<b>Armigero Sangiovese di Romagna Riserva, Emilia Romagna, Italy</b> <i>Lovely flavours of blackberries, dried fruits and spices.</i>	<b>£22.<sup>00</sup></b>
<b>Domaine Pellehaut Rouge, Cotes de Gascogne, France</b> <i>Soft and rounded with vibrant fruits and fragrant spice.</i>	<b>£23.<sup>00</sup></b>
<b>Château Gaury Balette Rouge, Entre Deux Mers, Bordeaux, France</b> <i>Classic Claret, delivered softly with fruit to the fore and nicely balanced structure.</i>	<b>£23.<sup>00</sup></b>
<b>Zapallar Pinot Noir Reserva, San Antonio, Chile</b> <i>Aromas of cherries and raspberries, well combined with soft notes of oak. In the mouth, smooth and elegant tannins are followed by sophisticated finish.</i>	<b>£25.<sup>00</sup></b>
<b>Gouguenheim Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina</b> <i>After spending 8 months in French oak barrel, this beautiful Malbec reveals aromas of red fruits, chocolate and coffee beans with scents of violets. The palate is very smooth with some complexity.</i>	<b>£28.<sup>00</sup></b>
<b>Valserrano Rioja Crianza, Rioja, Spain</b> <i>Red berry jam, balsamic and hints of oak this a tasty and well-rounded Rioja.</i>	<b>£30.<sup>00</sup></b>
<b>Château Rocher Calon, Montagne St-Emilion, Bordeaux, France</b> <i>Elegant and full bodied with robust red berry and cherry aromas follow through to blackberries and liquorice on the palate</i>	<b>£32.<sup>00</sup></b>
