- Prosecco Spumante Extra Dry, NV, Veneto, Italy** £25.00
Pale yellow gold in colour offering a bouquet of pear drops, lemon and melon. Light and fresh on the palate with a clean finish.
- Louis Boyier Brut, Champagne NV, France** £42.00
Crisp and dry with lovely biscuit and brioche flavours, this is a very elegant Champagne with great length.
- Louis Boyier Rose Brut, Champagne, NV, France** £45.00
A bouquet of honey and apricot, long lasting with a hint of quince jelly.
- Champagne Gosset Excellence, Brut, NV, France** £60.00
Intense nose of fresh floral honeysuckle and white jasmine followed by exotic pineapple and mango flavours.

- Crucillon Viura Blanco, Campo de Borja, Spain** £20.00
A lovely balanced white with stone fruits, citrus and floral lift.
- Mario's Bianco, 2016, Pelassa, Italy** £22.00
Lemon, lime and guava followed by pear and honey-baked bananas. Medium bodied on the palate with clean minerality, all framed by mouth-watering acidity.

- Vina Temprana 'Old Vines' Garnacha, Campo de Borja, Spain** £20.00
Ripe red berry fruits with lifted spice and soft tannins.
- Mario's Rosso, 2015, Pelassa, Italy** £22.00
Ruby red colour with violet shades; fruity, fragrant and persistent bouquet with suggestion of cherry, redcurrant and apricot flavours.



White Wine

Freedom Cross, Chenin Blanc, Franschhoek, South Africa <i>Ripe apple with tropical flavours leading to a clean, dry finish</i>	£22.⁰⁰
Amori, Pinot Grigio, Veneto, Italy <i>Crisp white wine with citrus aromas. Easy drinking and very refreshing.</i>	£22.⁰⁰
Belardent Picpoul de Pinet, Languedoc, France <i>Crisp and refreshing with zesty citrus notes, it's perfect for drinking in the garden. Vineyards are located in on the edges of the Thau Lagoon and are regarded as some of the oldest in the Mediterranean.</i>	£23.⁰⁰
Zapallar Sauvignon Blanc Reserva, San Antonio, Chile <i>This Sauvignon Blanc balances the grassy, cool climate style with delicate floral elderflower aromas and a little exotic fruit character.</i>	£23.⁰⁰
Mount Brown Sauvignon Blanc, Waipara, New Zealand <i>Intense passion fruit and ripe tropical fruits on the nose. Pineapple and exotic fruit Flavours backed up by a lemon-lime minerality lead this fine well-balanced wine to a palate of great depth and flavour with a dry citrus finish</i>	£25.⁰⁰
Petit Chablis Domaine d'Elise 2015, Burgundy, France <i>Chablis at its best with crisp green apple up front giving way to flinty mineral notes and creamy mouth feel.</i>	£28.⁰⁰
Arcan Albarino, Galicia, Spain <i>Galicia's signature grape variety displaying intense notes of white fruit, pears, citrus fruits and mouth-watering acidity</i>	£30.⁰⁰
Sancerre Domaine Millet Roger, Loire Valley, France <i>Concentrated gooseberry and citrus fruit, this wine is full of complexity with the classic minerality so traditional of Sancerre.</i>	£32.⁰⁰

Mediterrannée Rose d'Orange 2017, Rhone, France <i>A light and delicate rose with rose petal aromas and wild red berry flavours.</i>	£20.⁰⁰

Ladera Verde Merlot, Central Valley, Chile <i>Rich ripe dark fruits on the nose. The palate displays notes of blackcurrants, plums and damson with juicy acidity.</i>	£22.⁰⁰
Armigero Sangiovese di Romagna Riserva, Emilia Romagna, Italy <i>Lovely flavours of blackberries, dried fruits and spices.</i>	£22.⁰⁰
Château Gaury Balette Rouge, Entre Deux Mers, Bordeaux, France <i>Classic Claret, delivered softly with fruit to the fore and nicely balanced structure.</i>	£23.⁰⁰
Cotes du Rhone Vieilles Vignes Les Coteaux du Rhone, 2016, Rhone, France <i>Easy drinking with lots of fresh cherry and strawberry fruit flavours and fine tannins.</i>	£25.⁰⁰
Zapallar Pinot Noir Reserva, San Antonio, Chile <i>Aromas of cherries and raspberries, well combined with soft notes of oak. In the mouth, smooth and elegant tannins are followed by sophisticated finish.</i>	£25.⁰⁰
Gouguenheim Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina <i>After spending 8 months in French oak barrel, this beautiful Malbec reveals aromas of red fruits, chocolate and coffee beans with scents of violets. The palate is very smooth with some complexity.</i>	£28.⁰⁰
Valserrano Rioja Crianza, Rioja, Spain <i>Red berry jam, balsamic and hints of oak this a tasty and well-rounded Rioja.</i>	£30.⁰⁰
Château Rocher Calon, Montagne St-Emilion, Bordeaux, France <i>Elegant and full bodied with robust red berry and cherry aromas follow through to blackberries and liquorice on the palate</i>	£32.⁰⁰

Monbazillac Chateau de Fonmorgues, Monbazillac, France <i>A bouquet of honey and apricot, long lasting with a hint of quince jelly.</i>	£30.⁰⁰
Davy's Finest Reserve Port, Duoro, Portugal <i>Matured in oak casks in the lodges of Vila Nova de Gaia for up to 3 years. A full bodied sweet and fortified red wine with luscious fruit flavours of plum, dark berries and prunes. Round and delicious.</i>	£26.⁰⁰
